Digital agreement forms must be completed by parents prior to pick up. If you cannot pick up on these dates, your child will receive their iPad during the first few days of school.
- Any form of teasing, bullying, or harassment is not tolerated at PHHS and should be reported to any adult in the building so that the issue can be immediately addressed by the Assistant Principals.
- Parents are encouraged to monitor their child's attendance through Genesis Parent Portal. Notices for every 5th absence are delivered to the Parent Portal and students meet with the Assistant Principal.
