Dear Parents/Guardians:

On May 31st and June 1st, 2018, all 11th grade students will be taking the required New Jersey Student Learning Assessment for Science (NJSLA-S). The test is two hours long each day. Students taking the test should report to school as normal. 11th graders will be missing periods 1-3 completely. Parents wishing to refuse testing do not need to notify the school, but their child will be required to sit in the test site quietly as there will be no 11th grade classes for them to attend during periods 1-3. Make-ups will be held the following week. Please do your best to have your child sit for testing as make-ups will require lost instructional time and may impact their final exam reviews the following week. Please remind your children to charge their iPads as this is a digital exam, and be advised that as per normal testing procedures, cell phones, iPods, backpacks, purses, coats, food or drinks, are not allowed in the test sites. Students who violate this rule will have their tests voided.

12th Grade Students & Parents:

All students not involved in testing will follow a normal day bell schedule and classes will commence as normal. However, 12th grade students will be participating in our annual Senior Prom drinking and driving awareness program on May 31st, the day of the Prom. This will take place during periods 2 and 3 on the upper stadium field, and in the auditorium. Seniors will also view the 2018 Lip Dub for the first time. **Seniors wishing to sign out of school early for Prom need to have submitted a parent note to the attendance office, otherwise signing out of school will take longer than necessary to make phone calls to parents. Seniors cannot leave school earlier than 12:00 (when 5th period ends).** Also, please be advised that there will be a Senior Parent meeting in the auditorium on June 7th for graduation preparations. Student caps and gowns will be distributed at this meeting so please do your best to attend.
