# Attendance Policy

- $\frac{1}{2}$  year (semester course) no more than eight (8) absences
- $\frac{1}{4}$  year (Health/Drivers Education) no more than four (4) absences

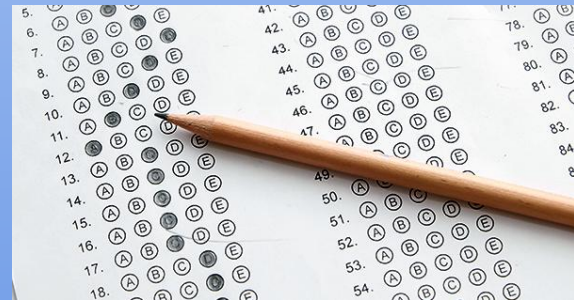

# 3. Test Scores

- It is the *student's responsibility* to have his/her SAT and/or ACT scores sent to CCM
- To send “Official” SAT and ACT scores:
  - Go to [www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com) (For SAT)
  - Go to [www.ACT.org](http://www.ACT.org) (For ACT)
  - The first 4 schools are included in registration
  - Log-on to websites to view and send scores
    - \$12.00 per school (SAT)
    - \$13.00 per school (ACT)
- Placement testing (Accuplacer)
